A proposal for the future of WCS Bandy was sent to all TC members. Kjell Anderstedt presents the proposal.

The TC representatives will have the possibility to study the proposal for some time. Next step is to have a meeting with Boris Skrynnik in December or January. When the FIB-decision is made, the conditions should be communicated to all member countries and externally on the FIB's website no later than the end of January 2022 so that the WCS in Syktyvkar 2022 can be arranged in a way so that the new form of the World Championships can be implemented in 2023.

### 4 SITUATION REGARDING COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRIES

Norway: 78% vaccinated. COVID is spreading a lot among the youth (10-19 years). Also new measures like face masks and distance.

Finland: 82% Fully vaccinated, but highest number of new infections now. No measures now.

Russia: Moscow is OK and getting better, but a lot of regions are not good.

Sweden: About 80% fully vaccinated. Sweden is open, no measures.

Netherlands: 88% fully vaccinated, but more infections than ever. Strong measures already. Hospitals expect a code black if nothing changes. Infections now >20.000 per day. Light lockdown now, expected is a complete lockdown.

WCS Y 17 Girls. Proposal from organizer is 2x45 in final games. Conditions and rules say 2x35.

There is a 16-year limit for WCS Senior men/women – Exemptions? Procedure? Answer: No limit in the official rules yet... Will be added to the adjusted Conditions.

WCS Women Stockholm: medals in group B?

Answer: yes, medals in group A and B.

Proposal for new Conditions (point for discussion): minimum 4 teams for three medals, if three teams: just two medals. What if only two teams?
