# 4 SITUATION REGARDING COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRIES

Norway: Not bad, all leagues are playing now. No restrictions, only recommendations.

Finland: Nothing changed, infections at the same level as last week, pressure on the

hospitals is OK. Discussion started in government on taking away restrictions.

Russia: Increasing number of infections per day, no serious problems in the hospitals.

Improvements on number of infections expected in 2-3 weeks.

Sweden: More sickness than ever (50-60.000 per day). A lot of games postponed. Two more weeks of current restrictions.

Netherlands: A lot is open again, but the number of infections is increasing very fast. Now 65.000 per day, 50% raise since last week. Expected a raise to 100.000 per day soon. Hospitals can handle it now.
