Report from workgroup "bandy in the future"

A proposal for the future of WCS Bandy was sent to all TC members. Kjell Anderstedt presents the proposal.

The TC representatives will have the possibility to study the proposal for some time. Next step is to have a meeting with Boris Skrynnik in December or January. When the FIB-decision is made, the conditions should be communicated to all member countries and externally on the FIB's website no later than the end of January 2022 so that the WCS in Syktyvkar 2022 can be arranged in a way so that the new form of the World Championships can be implemented in 2023.

4 SITUATION REGARDING COVID-19 IN THE COUNTRIES

Norway: Increasing number of infections, no big problems. No restrictions, only recommendations.

Finland: Not much changed, less infections, restrictions will soon decrease.

Russia: Increasing number of infections per day, same as last week.

Sweden: Little bit better than last week, opening expected.

Netherlands: Increasing number of infections, now more than 100.000 per day. No big

issues.

5 TIMETABLE

WCS Y21 Finland

Proposal of Finland is to move to 2-4 December 2022.

Sweden agrees with this proposal.

Russia is not ready to agree now. They need more time, because there are several players that must play also in the World Cup in Krasnoyarsk.

Postponed to next meeting.

WCS Women Sweden

Proposal for match schedule is sent out. Remarks can be sent to Anders Bergström.

WCS Group B in Syktyvkar

There still is no clear answer from Syktyvkar yet. RBF agrees to cancel. There are now only two teams left for participation (CZ and UKR). GB and SVK denied in the last week.

TC decides to cancel this tournament. FIB EC must confirm this.

FIB/Bo Nyman must send a letter to the organizing committee about this decision and the reasons.

RBF and organizing committee in Syktyvkar must discuss if the Group B tournament will be cancelled totally or moved to maybe October/December.

WCS Group A in Syktyvkar

Organizing committee need a letter from FIB/Bo Nyman, stating which teams will participate. Currently, 8 out of 9 teams have confirmed their participation. We are waiting for a decision from the USA.

WCS Y17 Boys Kemerovo

Team Europe applies for participation but asking for more exemptions than Conditions state. Players must be made aware that change of citizenship is only allowed one time! Decision later/next meeting.

Info from Kemerovo will be sent out soon. Currently, 5 teams participate (NOR, SWE, FIN, RUS, KAZ). If Team Europe will also participate, three days for the tournament might be not enough.

World Cup Krasnoyarsk and World Cup Veterans Arkhangelsk

The economical conditions for these tournaments are very good for the participating teams. Organizers cover the costs in Russia.

Mini World Cup Boys Y15

Swedish Bandy Federation applies for hosting this tournament for the next three seasons (2022-2023 is the first season).

COVID-19 Guidelines

- EU does not accept the Russian approved vaccine; Russia does not approve the EU approved vaccines.

The rules will be sent out to all federation.

Participating teams must have insurance covering the costs for COVID-19 related issues.
