### Age limit

In the TC meeting of 8 June 2020 was already decided:

## Minimum age limit to participate in senior WCS

Earlier decision changed: minimum of 16 years of age (before January 1) for both WCS men and WCS women.

### Minimum age limit to participate in junior WCS

Decision: minimum of 15 years of age (before January 1) for both WCS boys and WCS girls.

### Playing time WCS Women

2x30 or 2x45 minutes playing time? Teams in group A of the WCS Women in Växjö will be questioned.

- Gender equality: same as men? 18 players in the group?
- 2x45 minutes: maybe a rest day needed?

Discussion in next meeting.

This summer, Tor Audun Sørensen and Frank Peters will work on the revision of the Conditions.
