1 TIMETABLE

This meeting only had one discussion item. The timetable is adjusted conform text underneath.

Information from EC meeting of 31 May:
WCS Men group A, Irkutsk, Russia is postponed
WCS Men, Syktyvkar, Russia was already postponed

If the situation in the world will not change, alternatives for tournaments in Russia are needed. Especially Sweden and Norway should think about alternatives, also for WCS Y21 women and WCS Y19 boys.

Sweden: Next Saturday, elections for board and president. Current president will stop. Arne Anderstedt will stop his work in SBF, but wants to continue in FIB TC (two more years).
Norway: Elections for board and president coming up.
Finland: President wanted to stop. New president: Antti Parvianen (former headcoach). Also elected are three new members in the board (and a woman as vice-president).

Depending on all these new persons in charge, we wait what will happen.

Tournaments:

WCS Men Group A: Main focus lies here, a tournament is really important.

4-Nations: Norway does not organize. Finland is a question mark.

WCS Y21 women: regardless of location, Norway and Finland are not interested to participate (costs/no players). So, probably no WCS Y21 women.

WCS Y21 men: Finland, OK as planned.

WCS Y17 girls: Norway, OK as planned.

WCS Y17 boys: Can't be organized in Finland! Maybe Norway or Sweden?

There is a proposal from Sweden to host WCS Y17 boys and girls in one weekend in Sweden, and then WCS Y19 boys in Norway. But Norway want to be the host of WCS Y17 girls as planned. So, this is plan B.

Club tournaments:

WC Men: Russia, Krasnoyarsk: ?

WC Women: Sweden? Unclear if there is interest in Sweden.

WC Veterans: Haparanda, Finland?

EC Rinkbandy: Slovakia in September/October?

WC Y17 girls: Sweden, Skirö, Vetlanda 4-6/11

WC Y19 boys: Sweden, Åby/Tjureda 4-6/11

WC Y15 boys: Sweden, Bollnäs is unsure. SBF has to decide, they have the right to organize this tournament.

EC has to decide further about the situation in FIB in the coming season.

There is a working group to organize the Congress in September and to setup regulations for EC/Congress.

Maybe we should invite the presidents in Norway, Sweden and Finland for our next meeting in TC. This, to let them know where are we working at.
