1 SITUATION IN RUSSIA

Yury informs about the situation in Russia.

No changes, ready to participate at all tournaments, but understand that it is difficult. National competition goes as planned, for national teams no international matches now.

2 CONCLUSIONS WCS VÄXJÖ

In general Men A and Women combined was a success. Due to having only one arena available, 5+6 teams are about the maximum number of teams that can participate and then it is not even possible to play 2x45 minutes in all matches. Also starting at 08:00 or even 10:00h in the morning is (too) early. This means that under normal circumstances there are two arenas needed when combining Men and Women.

Equal rights for men and women are important in Sweden.

The financial conditions on this tournament are not sustainable in the future, especially B-countries are having big issues with this.

3 TIMETABLE

Some various subjects that were discussed.

We will not release a new timetable, we wait for the deadline of May 15.

Discuss in national boards, on agenda for next TC meeting:

- Do we want a world championships women every year or every second year? Think about Olympic future, gender equality, 2x45 minutes playing time etc. Originally planned is a WCS Women in 2024.
- We decided to start a workgroup promotion-relegation: think about it!
- See item 4: sanctions for breach of deadlines and protests.

WCS Y17/Y19 boys

For sure these tournaments must be played at the same time. If they can be also on the same place this would be a good thing. Easier for the national leagues, more spectators, more parents travelling etc. Last year the combination was a big success.

Question to Norway: can Norway host both tournaments at same time/place this season?

World Cups clubteams

Sweden might opt to organize all tournaments for boys and girls.
