### 1 TIMETABLE

#### **World Championships Boys Y17 Finland**

India will participate out of competition. They will play 2x15 minutes matches against Norway, Finland and Sweden. Also two matches against a local Y15 team of Kampparit.

**World Cup Boys Y19 Sweden** is cancelled due to lack of participating teams.

**Men 3-Nation's tournament** will be organized by SBF 19-21 January in Karlstad. SBF will ask FIB for sanctioning this tournament. Details will come in the near future. **Egil Larsen** would like to see referees from other countries than Sweden in this tournament. He will see if Norway can send a referee.

**Women:** SBF is thinking about organising a women's tournament at the end of March (on initial request of the USA). If it will take place SBF will ask FIB for sanctioning this tournament.

### 2 SHORT BANDY

**Egil Larsen** and RRC have looked into the playing rules. At this time RRC can not accept this type of bandy. RRC members have never seen it and are sceptical about some rules. Especially the corner stroke rule can be dangerous for defending teams with strong shooters. The question is also if we need a third discipline of bandy in FIB next to bandy and rinkbandy. Members think that short bandy is closer to bandy than rinkbandy, so maybe we should change rules of rinkbandy towards short bandy. More investigation is needed, **Egil Larsen** will contact Czech Bandy Federation.

### **3 ISSUES IN WORLD CUP TOURNAMENTS THIS SEASON**

Mixed teams have competed in competition where Technical Committee has decided that they should play out of competition. Teams also played in final matches which was not meant to be.

FIB/**Attila Adamfi** will send a letter to SBF asking for an explanation. SBF/**Pär Gustafsson** will evaluate with organizers and report back to TC.

For coming World Cup tournaments of this season there is a very clear document made and sent out with the rules concerning exemptions for World Cup tournaments. National federations are responsible for discussing this with organizers.

### **4 REVISED CONDITIONS AND GUIDELINES FOR ORGANIZERS**

We started discussing the proposal documents. No time left in the meeting, so next meeting we will continue where we left.

- Team Europe participation in WCS tournaments? (09-06-2023)
- International transfers – proposal Finland 20-04-2023 regarding players under 20 years – now in hands of FIB EC / Working group
- Website international transfers: payments to FIB, wishes (reports, inform applicant, now on temporary server, security, etc)
