FIB Secretary-General and representatives from FIB RRC and EC were present during most of the meetings.

Official meetings held in the period July 2021-June 2023: 24.

Mostly due to the COVID-19 pandemic, most of these meetings were online (some decisions were made by email discussions).

Most important issues/activities/decisions:

- In the mentioned time period, TC has put a lot of work in discussing and handling the sport in relation to COVID-19 and the situation regarding Russia-Ukraine.
- Time-table for FIB tournaments, a lot of tournaments had to be cancelled, relocated or postponed.
- Defining the international periods ("windows").
- Discussing issues regarding FIB tournaments (problems, difficulties, solutions etc.).
- Discussions on changes in the Conditions for senior and youth tournaments, both men and women (for example: age limits, gender equality).
- Composition or approval of match programs in FIB tournaments.
- TC representatives worked as tournament director in FIB tournaments.
- Financial conditions for various tournaments.

Other tasks of Technical Committee:

- Discussing about (adjusting) playing rules, together with Rules and Referee Committee
- Handling of referee reports (red cards) not processed by tournament juries
- Transfer regulations/fees
- Send proposals or advice to FIB Executive Committee
