## Most important issues/activities/decisions:

- Conditions for World Cup Clubs (WCC) tournaments were created. In the coming period we will evaluate these, also based on the experiences of organisers and participating teams in WCC tournaments this season. Also Conditions for World Championships (WCS) are under review.
- Time-table for FIB tournaments and defining the international periods ("windows").
- Discussing issues regarding FIB tournaments (problems, difficulties, solutions etc.).
- We have dealt with an enormous amount of exemption requests. Not only passport issues but also age related issues. Some of these requests were passed on to FIB Executive Committee.
- Revision of rules for equipment (goalie masks and gloves, skates/blades, sticks, shirts, balls etc).
- Composition or approval of match programs in FIB tournaments.
- TC members or representatives acted as tournament director or jury member in FIB tournaments.

## Tasks in progress:

- We discuss the addition of Short Bandy as a new discipline in FIB, next to bandy and rinkbandy. Especially for new and smaller bandy nations (southern Europe, USA) this could be an interesting option. RRC is now working on adjusting the playing rules to FIB's standard.

## Other tasks of Technical Committee:

- Discussing about (adjusting) playing rules, together with RRC.
- Handling of referee reports (red cards) not processed by tournament juries.
- Transfer regulations/fees.
- Send proposals or advice to FIB Executive Committee.
