1. Opening of the Meeting

3. FIB Development Camp

Discussion Points:

- Draft Requirements were reviewed and accepted as a working base.
- Locations discussed:
 - o Uppsala
 - Mölndal
 - o Stockholm ruled out due to high ice rental costs and lack of availability
- Teaching staff (Instructors): discussion on difficulty securing full-time instructors; potentially rotating coaches per session, as in the previous camp
- Suggested camp dates:
 - Second half of November 2025
 - o First half of December 2025
 - o January March ruled out as too late in the season

Agreed action points:

- Janet Duke will draft an email to Group B national federations, including:
 - Estimation of participant numbers: separately for womens / mens and for players / coaches
 / referees
 - o Preferred dates (select from 2 proposed options)
 - o Provisional cost (~€250 per person for 3-day weekend)
 - o Preliminary schedule

- o Response deadline from federations: 15 August 2025
- Michael Bratt will submit a short written proposal from Mölndal, including logistical and cost information

4. Clean Sport Educator Course (ITA)

Mikhail Entaltsev shared information about the International Testing Agency (ITA) online course on antidoping education for sports educators. EDC members are encouraged to review the material and consider participation. The registration deadline is 1 August 2025.

5. Any other business

- Summer Camps for Youth Players: Janet Duke is preparing a list of summer bandy camps in Sweden that are open to international participants (especially those who don't speak Swedish) Goal: Provide easy global access to information about youth bandy summer camps for players and parents via the FIB website. The document will include camp formats, approximate costs, a contact person for each camp, and a general contact.
- Michael Bratt proposed structuring coach education into two phases:
 - o An in-person seminar
 - o Follow-up online modules

The aim is to establish consistent, high-quality coaching standards across nations.

Regular thematic Zoom sessions were also suggested as a tool for continued education and long-term development.
