1 TOPICS IN PROGRESS

1.1 Short bandy

2 INCOMING – FOR INFORMATION

It appears that the IOC may become more milder in the near future regarding the participation of Russian and Belarussian youth teams in team sports (with additional conditions). To be clear: even after IOC gives the green light, it will be up to FIB to consider how to handle this situation. We don't expect any changes this season, but we will need to consider this for next seasons.

Group Allocation, proposal from workgroup:

- To group A in Pori: Finland, Norway, Sweden, USA for men and women.
- Other teams to groups B.

Main reasons for this proposal:

- we are only 4 months before the WCS in Pori and decisions must be made
- the participation of Kazakhstan men-team is very uncertain
- serious issues when a group has 5 teams (every day one team has the day off; one team starts the tournament one day later; which team has the day off the day before the semi-finals?)
- the Netherlands was ready to participate with their men team in Pori, but also prefers 6 teams in the group

Proposal accepted.
