3. Hall of Fame proposal

The chair had a meeting with the General Secretary, Attila Adamfi. The AC proposes that a more realistic criteria for player inclusion would be participation over a span of a certain number of years, or participation in a certain number of world championships. To be more inclusive and achievable, the AC concludes that for men, 50 WCS or 75 international games, and for women, 25 WCS or 40 international

games would be appropriate. With men playing about 6 or 7 games per WCS, each year, this could be achieved in about 8 or 9 years. With women playing 5 or 6 games per WCS, every other year, would take 8 or 9 years to achieve.

4. Athlete365

Athlete365 is a digital community platform for Olympians, elite athletes, and their “entourage” (coaches, family, sponsors) to provide learning resources, courses on mental health, media training. It supports elite athletes both during and after their sporting career, with career transitions, health and well-being, and clean sport.

When more athletes in a sport register on Athlete365, it shows the IOC how large, active, and engaged that sport’s athlete community really is. The IOC tracks participation to understand which sports are growing, which have strong global athlete communities, and helps build the sport’s case for Olympic inclusion.
