1 SHORT BANDY PLAYING RULES

All changes were earlier approved in Technical Committee meetings. Changed are rules 1.2 (boarding); 2.4 (goalie vest); 11 (corners).

2 GUIDELINES TO ORGANIZERS

Final document version for approval was sent with the invitation to this meeting.
All changes were earlier approved in Technical Committee meetings. Changed are articles 1.17 (awards); 2.10 (game protocols); 3.9 (doping control room).

In the document, references to RRC must be changed to the new name RC.

3 CONDITIONS

Various incoming items discussed.

CHANGE to all Conditions art. 8: Jury members and Tournament Directors nominated by TC / RC (do not need to be members in TC or RC).

Proposed text (for WCS Senior): In the Jury, at least 3 countries must be represented at every decision. A person **nominated** by TC or **RC** can be replaced by an other person **nominated by** the same committee in case there is a protest involving the country of the jury-member.

Decision: Approved.

ADD to all Conditions art. 7.3: Teamleader meeting decides about persons in panel for awards (See Guidelines 1.17)

Decision: Approved.

CHANGE of WCC/WCS Youth: art. 5.6 exemptions, move to article 3 age/gender? Or just mention in article 3 the exemption rule 5.6

Decision: Approved, just cross reference articles 3 and 5.6.

REQUEST from Athletes Committee: medals for pools as well (nowadays only for groups)

Decision: Not approved. Medals will be supplied to pool/group B if the teams in pool/group B can not become world champion. If all women teams participate in one tournament, FIB must create a schedule where all teams can become world champion.

In all Conditions documents, references to RRC must be changed to the new name RC.

4 PLAYING RULES

Question: We will soon have three disciplines in FIB – separate documents for these needed?

Decision after a short discussion: no separate documents needed, otherwise a lot of identical information will be in three documents.

5 ANY OTHER BUSINESS

Tor Audun Sørensen will resign from this committee after the season. Tor Audun hopes that the Norwegian Bandy Federation will propose **Bent Gommerud** as his replacement. Bent will also be available as secretary for this committee.

For tournaments where representatives of member associations shall be appointed to the jury (WCS and WCC Youth), we must ask the associations beforehand for the names of these persons.

Information from IOC regarding participation of RUS/BLR.

The IOC changed their recommendation regarding the participation of Russian and Belarussian youth teams in team sports (with additional conditions). It will be up to FIB to consider how to handle this situation.
