1 FIB INTERNATIONAL TRANSFER REGULATIONS - ITC DRAFT 2026

Attila Adamfi briefed us on the review he and Stein have done of the transfer regulations. It is discussed with **Frank Peters** and partly with **Kristian Marosi** because of Profixio (see under). It is also reviewed by **Krister Malmsten**, with some small adjustments.

The transfer fee will be raised from 300 Euro to 500 US dollars. The compensation for education will also be raised from 6.000 Euro to 10.000 US dollars. These amounts were unchanged since 2004. The payment will go to FIB first, then FIB will pay the former Member Association after. The new rules will be functioning from July.

There also was a discussion about the end date of the international transfer window. But no change was made for now. But it may be an issue in the future with three different sports in the FIB family.

The current FIB transfer system website will be replaced by a system via Profixio.

Decision: All agree and approve and Attila Adamfi will finish the regulations.

2 WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP FOR WOMEN IN USA 2027

There were questions about the participation in the proposed world championship next year in Minneapolis. The Netherlands will probably come. Finland has a tight economy.

3 GOVERNANCE REPORT JURY TEMPLATES

Kristian Marosi mentions that there is a start made with a governance report formalizing the jury templates for all our championships. Examples are jury members, mandate, red cards, protests etc. He, **Frank Peters** and **Attila Adamfi** will work further on this.
