



INVITATION TO THE 2026 FIB WORLD CUP CLUB TEAMS MEN 17 Stockholm, Sweden 4-6 January

Organizers:	The Swedish Bandy Federation, Tellus and GT76
Date:	4-6 January, 2026. The tournament starts in the afternoon of the 4th.
Place:	Gubbängens indoor arena (maybe a few games to be played on the outdoor arena, also located in Gubbängens Sports field)
Fees:	<p>Registration fee, 7.000 SEK per team and participation fee, per each player/team leader, 1.850 SEK. <i>Included in participation fee:</i> 2 nights in a hotel in Stockholm (breakfast included), 3 lunches, (Sunday, Monday, Tuesday), 2 dinners (Sunday, Monday). Lunch and dinner served at Gubbängens indoor arena.</p> <p><u><i>NOTE: Tuesday 6 January is a public holiday in Sweden as in many other European countries.</i></u></p> <p>The fees shall be paid <u>no later than 15 October</u> after confirmation of participation from the organizer.</p>

Travel to Gubbängen:	15-20 minutes by bus, car or public transport from the accommodation.
Players age:	Born no earlier than 2009 and born no later than 2011.
Number of teams:	Maximum 10 teams
Number of games:	Minimum 4 games per team.
List of players:	<p><u>A preliminary</u> list stating maximum 26 players plus referee(s)(supervisor) including names, passport (or national identity card) copies, dates of birth, domiciles and merits is to be sent to the FIB General Secretary attila.adamfi@worldbandy.com at the latest 6 weeks (23 November) before the start of the tournament. Of these 26 players, max. 22 are field players and max. 4 are goalkeepers. If any of the players are injured in the period between the preliminary list and the final list, these may be replaced.</p> <p><u>Final team set-up:</u> A final list stating 16 players plus 10 substitutes is to be sent to the FIB General Secretary at least 10 days (25 December) before the</p>

start of the tournament. The players and the substitutes must be the same as in the preliminary list. Should, at a later date any of the players listed in the final team set-up be exchanged because of an injury (or extraordinary reasons approved by FIB), only the 10 listed substitutes can be used (a confirmation from a doctor or proof is required).

Playing time: 2 x 30 minutes, 5 min half time. Ice care after each game.
