1 FAIR PLAY AWARD IN GUIDELINES TO ORGANIZERS

In Norway they awarded “Best Fair Play team” in top league men until some years ago. So in Sweden and Finland. It was based objectively on sum up penalties (5.min., 10. min., and directly red card 45 min.) from the official match reports. The sum up was only based on the ground league matches, because in play off the teams played odd number of matches.

Experientially and primarily the teams want to win the league and medals. They do not really care about winning Fair Play award/cup. If a team wins gold medal it is may be OK to also win the Fair Play award/cup, but if the team for instance became number 2 or 3 in the league, it was almost “a joke” to be handed this award.

An imaginary example: The sum up after ground league in WCS men group A results in team Canada winning the Fair Play Award. In the WCS final game Canada beat Australia 4-3. But a Canadian player got directly red card in the 87.th minute for brutal action against opponent.

Decision: We remove the prize from the Guidelines.

2 SCHEDULE OF WCS MENS GROUP B

It will be unfair that one of the teams will have one day off during the WC. This is a problem when there are 5 teams in the tournament. **Kristian Marosi** and **Kjell Anderstedt** will discuss a proposal, and we will take a decision later.

3 SCHEDULE OF WCS YOUTH

Andreas Sjöblom propose to skip the semifinals on Sunday morning in WCC Youth in Uppsala.

Decision: There will be no semifinals this WCS for youths. The finals will be played earlier on Sunday to give Finland to chance to leave for home Sunday evening..

4 TEMPLATES FOR THE JURY IN CHAMPIONSHIPS

We need to formalize the jury templates for all our championships. This is important. Examples are jury members, mandate, red cards, protests etc.

Decision: Kristian Marosi, Attila Adamfi and Frank Peters will make a template for the jury in international tournaments in FIB.
