In October 2025, after a decision in FIB Executive Committee, some tasks of the Technical Committee were allocated to a new formed Competition Committee.

Meetings were attended by one or more other persons when the items needed input from other persons, who are more knowledgeable or better informed on discussed topics.

Amount of official meetings held in the period March 2025-December 2025: 7.

Most important issues/activities/decisions:

- Time-table for FIB tournaments and defining the international periods (“windows”).
- Discussing issues regarding FIB tournaments (problems, difficulties, solutions etc.).
- Above mentioned activities are now the responsibility of the new Competition Committee.

- Short Bandy is in TC accepted as a new discipline in FIB, next to bandy and rinkbandy. Especially for new and smaller bandy nations (southern Europe, USA) this could be an interesting option. The playing rules are revised to FIB's standard and member associations were asked for comments which were handled.
- Conditions for World Cup Clubs (WCC) tournaments were created before. We have now evaluated these, also based on the experiences of organisers and participating teams in WCC tournaments last season. We have made a number of changes based on these evaluations.
- Also the other Conditions and “Guidelines For Organizers” were reviewed. The Athletes Committee was also asked for input. Several changes have been made to make the documents more practical and future proof (among others: age limits youth players, maximum numbers of players, dates for sending in preliminary players-lists).
- Equipment rules (especially goalie masks).
- Composition or approval of match programs in FIB tournaments.
- TC members or representatives acted as tournament director or jury member in FIB tournaments.

Tasks in progress:

- International transfers document (transfer regulations/fees)
