1 What items are we going to discuss this season?

Kristian Marosi would like to have the same rules for top scorers in all FIB tournaments. He would also have one book of rules for all three branches. The book of rules also needs to be translated to proper English. Atilla would like to modernize the book of rules. Kristian also suggested that the play system should be the same for all FIB tournaments.

Attila informed that the new international transfer platform is up and running. The national federations have been informed about the new system and one person in the federations are responsible for this. So far, everything looks good.

2 The Kosa ball and other equipment issues.

Neal had a question about the new Kosa bandyball and the approval. The ball is not formally approved yet. But Kosa is experimenting with a sensor inside the ball. We discussed the procedure when equipment shall be approved by FIB.

Arne thought it is important that the players are participating in the process of developing equipment. Kristian meant the manufacturers should be responsible for this, not FIB.

3 Short bandy rules

There will be a short bandy tournament in Switzerland in September. There are 6 teams playing this tournament. After this tournament, we will look at changes of the short bandyrules.
